(Overseas Territories) Order 2012**

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 112 of the Saint Helena Act 1833<sup>(1)</sup>, the British Settlement Acts 1887<sup>(2)</sup> and 1945<sup>(3)</sup>, section 1 of the United Nations Act 1946<sup>(4)</sup>, and section 16(5) of the Export Control Act 2002<sup>(5)</sup>, is pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is ordered, as follows:

**Citation, commencement and extent**

1. This Order may be cited as the Restrictive Measures (Amendment) (Overseas Territories) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th March 2012.

**Amendments to certain instruments**

2.—(1) The instruments listed in Schedule 1 are amended as follows.

(2) For “St Helena and its Dependencies”, “Saint Helena and Dependencies”, “St Helena and Dependencies” or “St. Helena and Dependencies”, wherever occurring, substitute “St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha”.

3.—(1) The instruments listed in Schedule 2 are amended as follows.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE***(This note is not part of the Order)*

The St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Constitution Order 2009 changed the name of the territory of St Helena and Dependencies to St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha. This Order amends a number of statutory instruments that deal with restrictive measures to reflect this change of name.

This Order also revokes four statutory instruments dealing with restrictive measures, which have ceased to have effect.
