## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into force in relation to England provisions of the Flood and Water Management Act 2010 (c. 29).

Article 3 specifies provisions of that Act that come into force (so far as not already commenced) on 30th July 2013 in relation to England only. These provisions amend the Reservoirs Act 1975 (c. 23) to introduce a new legal framework relating to the safety of large raised reservoirs.

Article 4 contains transitional and savings provisions relating to the amendments of the Reservoirs Act 1975.
