**The Employment Tribunals (Interest)
Order (Amendment) Order 2013**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14 and 41 of the Employment Tribunals Act 1996⁽¹⁾, and sections 139(1)(b), 139(2) and 207 of the Equality Act 2010⁽²⁾, and with the approval of the Treasury, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order (Amendment) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 29th July 2013.

Amendment of the Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990

2. In paragraph (1) of Article 2 of the Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990⁽³⁾ omit the definition of “the calculation day” and insert—

““the calculation day” in relation to a relevant decision day means the day immediately following the relevant decision day;”.

3. In Article 3 of the Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990 insert—

“(4) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), no interest shall be payable if payment of the full amount of the award (including any interest under regulation 2 of the Employment Tribunals (Interest on Awards in Discrimination Cases) Regulations 1996⁽⁴⁾) is made within 14 days after the relevant decision day.”.
