**166.** In Schedule 1 to the Equality Act 2010 (Specific Duties) Regulations 2011 <sup>M1</sup> (public authorities required to publish information by 31st January 2012)—

- (a) after the entry beginning “An NHS trust” insert—
  - “A clinical commissioning group established under section 14D of that Act.
  - The National Health Service Commissioning Board.
  - The National Institute for Health and Care Excellence.
  - The Health and Social Care Information Centre.”,
- (b) omit the entry beginning “A Primary Care Trust”, and
- (c) omit the entry beginning “A Strategic Health Authority”.
