## The Road Vehicles (Testing) (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2013

## PART 1

#### **Duty to Review**

4. After regulation 18, insert—

### "Review of regulation 18

**18A.**—(1) The Secretary of State must—

- (a) conduct a review of the operation and effect of those provisions of regulation 18 that relate to the efficiency of brakes;
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
- (c) publish a report.

(2) In carrying out the review the Secretary of State must, so far as is reasonable, have regard to how, insofar as it relates to braking efficiencies, Directive 2009/40/EC(1) is implemented in other member States of the EU.

(3) The report must in particular—

- (a) set out the objectives intended to be achieved by those provisions of regulation 18 that relate to the efficiency of brakes;
- (b) assess the extent to which those objectives are achieved; and
- (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved with a system that imposes less regulation.
- (4) The first report under this regulation must be published before 20th March 2018.

(5) Reports under this regulation are afterwards to be published at intervals not exceeding five years.".
