## ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 34, Southbound Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 6th November 2013

Coming into force - - 10th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of Lancaster in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 34, Southbound Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 10th November 2013.

## 2. In this Order:

"motorway" means the M6 Motorway;

"works" means cores to be taken in the hard shoulder and lane 1 of the motorway;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0600 hours starting on Monday 11 November 2013 and ending on Thursday 14 November 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed;

"the slip roads" means the entry and exit slip roads leading to and from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 34.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
