The Food Safety and Hygiene (England) Regulations 2013

Review

- **41.**—(1) The Food Standards Agency must from time to time
 - (a) carry out a review of the operation and effect of regulations 2 to 35;
 - (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
 - (c) publish the report.
- (2) In carrying out the review the Agency must, so far as is reasonably practicable, have regard to how the EU instruments mentioned in paragraph $[^{F1}(1)]$ as read with paragraph $[^{F2}(6)]$ of regulation 2 are executed and enforced in other Member States.
 - (3) The report must in particular
 - (a) set out the objectives intended to be achieved by the regulatory system established by these Regulations;
 - (b) assess the extent to which those objectives are achieved; and
 - (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved with a system that imposes less regulation.
- (4) The first report under this regulation must be published before the end of the period of five years beginning with the day on which these Regulations come into force.
- (5) Reports under this regulation are afterwards to be published at intervals not exceeding five years.
