ROAD TRAFFIC

The M42 and M6 Motorways (M42 Junction 8 to 7) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 27th December 2013

Coming into force - - 3rd January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”), the M6 Motorway (“the M6”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 and M6 Motorways (M42 Junction 8 to 7) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 3rd January 2014.

2. In this Order:

| “the motorway” | means the southbound carriageway of the M42 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 8 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 7; |
| “the link road” | means the road leading from the M6 to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at M6 Junction 4a. |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Tuesday 7th January 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
