The Personal Independence Payment (Transitional Provisions) Regulations 2013

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 93 and 94 of, and Schedule 10 to, the Welfare Reform Act 2012(1), makes the following regulations.

These Regulations are made under the provisions of that Act and are made before the end of a period of 6 months beginning with the coming into force of those provisions of that Act(2).
