**The Criminal Legal Aid (Determinations by a Court

PART 3

Choice of representative

Determinations by the Director in certain cases in the Crown Court

22.—(1) The Director may, upon the committal, transfer or sending for trial of an individual, determine that the individual can select a Queen’s Counsel without a junior advocate if the proceedings are a trial for murder.

(2) The Director may, upon receipt of a notice of transfer of an individual’s case under section 4 of the Criminal Justice Act 1987⁽¹⁾, determine that the individual can select a Queen’s Counsel with one junior advocate if the prosecution is brought by the Serious Fraud Office.
