ENTITLEMENT TO OTHER BENEFITS

Exclusion of entitlement to certain benefits

- 5.—(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), a claimant is not entitled to—
 - (a) income support;
 - (b) housing benefit;
 - (c) a tax credit; or
 - (d) state pension credit F1... M1

in respect of any period when the claimant is entitled to universal credit M2.

- (2) Entitlement to universal credit does not preclude the claimant from entitlement—
- [F2(a) to housing benefit in respect of specified accommodation or temporary accommodation;]
- [F2(ab) to housing benefit or income support where regulation 8(2A) [F3 or 46(1)] applies; F4...]
 - (b) during the first assessment period for universal credit, where the claimant is a new claimant partner, to—
 - (i) income support, where an award to which the new claimant partner is entitled terminates, in accordance with regulation 7(4), after the first date of entitlement to universal credit;
 - (ii) housing benefit, where regulation 7(5)(b) [F5 or (c)] applies and an award of housing benefit to which the new claimant partner is entitled terminates after the first date of entitlement to universal credit; F6...
 - (iii) a tax credit, where an award to which the new claimant partner is entitled terminates, in accordance with the 2002 Act, after the first date of entitlement to universal credit [F7]; or
 - (iv) state pension credit, where an award to which the new claimant partner is entitled terminates after the first date of entitlement to universal credit; or]
- [F7(c) during the last assessment period for universal credit, where the claimant reaches the qualifying age for state pension credit and paragraph 26 of Schedule 1 to the Decisions and Appeals Regulations applies, to housing benefit or state pension credit from the date the claimant reaches that age]
