ROAD TRAFFIC

The A63 Trunk Road (Hull Jane Tomlinson 10k Run) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - -

29th May 2014

Coming into force -

7th June 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Kingston upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A (2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Hull Jane Tomlinson 10k Run) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 7th June 2014.

2. In this Order:-

“the A63” means the A63 Trunk Road;

“the slip road” means the A63 eastbound exit slip road at Garrison Road Roundabout;

“event” means the Jane Tomlinson 10k Run;

“the event period” means a period between 09:15 hours and 09:50 hours on Sunday 8th June 2014, continuing as necessary to facilitate the holding of the event.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the event period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicle being used in connection with the charity run event, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
