**The A36 Trunk Road (Heytesbury to Deptford, Wiltshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - 22nd July 2014

Coming into force - - 26th July 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads between Heytesbury and Deptford in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Heytesbury to Deptford, Wiltshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 26th July 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means the A36 between the eastern edge of Cotley Hill Roundabout at Heytesbury and a point at the centre of the A303 / A36 Deptford Junction;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the A303 westbound to the A36 northbound at the Deptford Junction;

“the works” mean safety improvements to the junction of Manor Road and the A36 at Upton Lovell including the installation of 4 way permanent traffic signals, a right turn lane from the A36 southbound to Manor Road, a new pedestrian crossing, drainage, footpath widening, resurfacing, traffic signal loop installation, white lining and studding;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 28th July 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 28th July 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A36 and the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the A36 to turn into Manor Road near Upton Lovell.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction or with the permission of a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (d) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.
