1. This Order—

- (a) may be cited as the Control of Noise (Code of Practice on Noise from Audible Intruder Alarms) (Revocation) (England) Order 2014;
- (b) applies in England; and
- (c) comes into force on 1st October 2014.

2. The Control of Noise (Code of Practice on Noise from Audible Intruder Alarms) Order 1981(b) is revoked.
