The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 (Commencement No. 1) (Northern Ireland) Order 2014

Provisions coming into force on 15th September 2014

- **2.** The following provisions of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 come into force in Northern Ireland on 15th September 2014—
 - (a) section 1 (individual registration);
 - (b) section 2(1) to (5) (applications for registration and verification of entitlement etc);
 - (c) section 4 (annual canvass);
 - (d) section 5 (invitations to register);
 - (e) section 7 (power to amend or abolish the annual canvass);
 - (f) section 8 (consulting Electoral Commission about proposals under section 7);
 - (g) section 9 (piloting of changes to the annual canvass);
 - (h) section 12 (interpretation of Part 1);
 - (i) section 13(1) and (2) (amendments and transitional provision), so far as not already in force;
 - (j) Schedule 1 (register of electors: alterations and removal);
 - (k) Schedule 3 (civil penalty for failing to make application when required by registration officer);
 - (1) Schedule 4 (amendments to do with Part 1), with the exception of—
 - (i) paragraph 9(4)(b),
 - (ii) paragraph 10(5), and
 - (iii) paragraph 23, so far as it omits paragraphs 5 and 6(2) of Schedule 1 to the Electoral Administration Act 2006(1); and
 - (m) Schedule 5 (transitional provision to do with Part 1), so far as not already in force.
