- (d) Schedule 16 (local listed building consent orders: procedure); and
- (e) paragraphs 11 and 14 to 19 of Schedule 17 (consequential amendments to the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup>) and section 63 so far as relating to those paragraphs.
