**The RAF Barford St John Byelaws 2014**

*Made* - - - - *19th March 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *19th July 2014*

The Secretary of State for Defence makes the following byelaws in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Military Lands Act 1892(1).

In accordance with section 17(1) of that Act the Secretary of State before making these byelaws caused the proposed byelaws to be made known in the locality, gave an opportunity for objections being made to the same, and received and considered all objections made.

(1) 1892 c. 43. Section 2(3) of the Defence (Transfer of Functions) Act 1964 (c. 15) enables the Secretary of State to make byelaws under Part II of the Military Lands Act 1892 to regulate land used for any purpose of his department or of any of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces, as if any such purpose were a military purpose within the meaning of the said Part II. Pursuant to the Statutory Instruments Act 1946 (c. 36), regulation 2 of the Statutory Instruments Regulations 1947 (S.I. 1948/1) and section 4 of the Rules Publication Act 1893 (1893 c. 66) such byelaws are statutory instruments.
