The Clifton Suspension Bridge (Revision of Tolls) Order 2014

Made - - - - *24th March 2014*

Coming into force - - *31st March 2014*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Transport Charges &c. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954^(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Clifton Suspension Bridge (Revision of Tolls) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 31st March 2014.

2. The Trustees of the Clifton Suspension Bridge may demand, take and recover for the use of the Clifton Suspension Bridge, tolls not exceeding those specified in the Schedule to this Order in lieu of the tolls which are specified in the third schedule to the Clifton Suspension Bridge Act 1952^(b).

3. The Clifton Suspension Bridge Tolls (Revision) Order 2006^(c) is revoked.

Class 1	Motor Vehicles of any description (except any included in classes 2 and 3 below) and vehicles drawn by a horse or other animal-for each vehicle.	£1

Class 3	Pedestrians, pedal cycles, handcarts, mechanically propelled invalid carriages, horses and other animals-for each pedestrian, cycle, cart, carriage or animal.	Nil

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order, made in response to an application to the Secretary of State under section 6 of the Transport Charges &c (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954 by the Trustees of the Clifton Suspension Bridge, revises the maximum tolls that the Trustees may charge for use of the Clifton Suspension Bridge. These new toll levels supersede the toll levels set out in the third schedule to the Clifton Suspension Bridge Act 1952 as revised by previous amending orders, the last of which was the Clifton Suspension Bridge Tolls (Revision) Order 2006.
