#### Threshold amounts

- **5.**—(1) This Part applies to procurements with a value [F1 inclusive] of VAT estimated to be equal to or greater than the following thresholds:—
  - (a) for public works contracts, [F2£5,372,609];
  - (b) for public supply contracts and public service contracts awarded by central government authorities, and design contests organised by such authorities, [F3£139,688], subject to paragraph (2);
  - (c) for public supply contracts and public service contracts awarded by sub-central contracting authorities, and design contests organised by such authorities, [F4£214,904];
  - (d) for public service contracts for social and other specific services listed in Schedule 3, [F5£663,540].
  - (2) Where public supply contracts are—
    - (a) awarded by central government authorities operating in the field of defence, and
    - (b) concern products not covered by Schedule 4,

the applicable threshold for the purposes of paragraph (1) is the sum specified in  $I^{F6}$  paragraph (1)(c)].
