**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Scottish Highlands)  
(Revocation) Regulations 2015**

*Made* - - - - *3rd August 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *4th August 2015*

The Secretary of State previously considered it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the Scottish Highlands and certain approaches to the Scottish Highlands, by reason of the intended operational low-flying training which takes place there.

The procedures for the use of the Scottish Highland for such training having now been amended, the Secretary of State no longer deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in that area and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Scottish Highlands) (Revocation) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 4th August 2015.

**Revocation of Regulations**

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Scottish Highlands) Regulations 2008(b) are revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations revoke the instrument which imposed restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of the Scottish Highlands.

In view of the fact that the procedures for operational low-flying training in that area have been amended, the previous restrictions on flying are no longer required.
