The Packaging (Essential Requirements) Regulations 2015

PART 5

Miscellaneous

Review

12.—(1) The Secretary of State must from time to time—

- (a) carry out a review of the effect of these Regulations,
- (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
- (c) publish the report.

(2) [^{F1}In carrying out the review the Secretary of State must, so far as is reasonable, have regard to how articles 9 and 11 of the Directive (which is implemented by means of these Regulations) are implemented in [^{F2}other] member States.]

(3) The report must in particular—

- (a) set out the objectives to be achieved by the regulatory system established by these Regulations,
- (b) assess the extent to which those objectives have been achieved; and
- (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved with a system that imposes less regulation.

(4) The first report under this regulation must be published before the end of the period of five years beginning with the day on which these Regulations come into force.

(5) Reports under this regulation are afterwards to be published at intervals not exceeding five years.
