Review

- 12.—(1) The Secretary of State must from time to time—
 - (a) carry out a review of the effect of these Regulations,
 - (b) set out the conclusions of the review in a report; and
 - (c) publish the report.
- (2) [FIIn carrying out the review the Secretary of State must, so far as is reasonable, have regard to how articles 9 and 11 of the Directive (which is implemented by means of these Regulations) are implemented in [F2other] member States.]
 - (3) The report must in particular—
 - (a) set out the objectives to be achieved by the regulatory system established by these Regulations,
 - (b) assess the extent to which those objectives have been achieved; and
 - (c) assess whether those objectives remain appropriate and, if so, the extent to which they could be achieved with a system that imposes less regulation.
- (4) The first report under this regulation must be published before the end of the period of five years beginning with the day on which these Regulations come into force.
- (5) Reports under this regulation are afterwards to be published at intervals not exceeding five years.
