<b>How to vote</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>When you receive your postal vote, read the instructions carefully.</li><li>Your postal vote includes your ballot paper and a declaration of identity.</li><li>Complete the declaration of identity.</li><li>Complete the ballot paper.</li><li>Return your postal voting papers in the envelope provided.</li><li>We need to receive your postal vote by <b>10pm on [day/date of poll]</b>. Postal voting papers cannot be accepted at polling stations.</li></ol>	<b>If you make a mistake:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Please phone the helpline immediately.</li><li>We can only issue a replacement postal vote if you return all your postal vote documents by <b>5pm on [day/date of deadline]</b>.</li></ul> <p>If you would rather vote in person, or ask someone else to vote on your behalf, you must cancel your postal vote <b>before 5pm on [day/date of deadline]</b>.</p> <p>[*Note that if you have an anonymous entry on the register you will not be able to vote in person, but you can ask someone else to vote by post on your behalf.]</p> <p>*Returning Officer to only include on postal poll card sent to an anonymous elector.</p>
