Competent Authorities and ADR Entities

[^{F1}Agreement to submit disputes to an ADR entity

14B. An agreement between a consumer and a trader to submit a ^{F2}... domestic dispute to an ADR entity is not binding on the consumer to the extent that the agreement—

- (a) was concluded before the ^{F2}... domestic dispute materialised; and
- (b) has the effect of depriving the consumer of the right to bring judicial proceedings in relation to the ^{F2}...domestic dispute.]
