- N. Development consisting of—
 - (a) a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use as—
 - (i) an amusement arcade or centre, or
 - (ii) a casino,
 - to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of the Schedule to the Use Classes Order; [Flor]
 - (b) I^{F2} development referred to in paragraph (a) together with building operations reasonably necessary to convert the building referred to in paragraph (a) to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule.
