PART 9

Development relating to roads

Class E – repairs to unadopted streets and private ways

Permitted development

E. *The carrying out on land within the boundaries of an unadopted street or private way of works required for the maintenance or improvement of the street or way.*

Interpretation of Class E

E.1 For the purposes of Class E, “unadopted street” means a street not being a highway maintainable at the public expense within the meaning of the Highways Act 1980 ^{M1}.
