The Town and Country Planning (Compensation) (England) Regulations 2015

Citation, commencement, application and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Compensation) (England) Regulations 2015 and shall come into force on 15th April 2015.
 - (2) These Regulations apply in relation to England only.
 - (3) In these Regulations—

"the Act" means the Town and Country Planning Act 1990;

"the Permitted Development Order" means the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 M1; and

"the Procedure Order" means Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015 $^{\rm M2}$.
