The Nagoya Protocol (Compliance) Regulations 2015

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1

The Secretary of State, who is designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(1) in relation to the environment(2), makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by that section of that Act.
