The Mortgage Credit Directive Order 2015

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

^{M3}In the opinion of the Treasury, one of the effects of this Order is that an activity which is not a regulated activity, within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000, will become a regulated activity.
