Duty to keep technical documentation and ^{F1}... declaration of conformity **E+W+S**

12. A manufacturer must keep the technical documentation and the ^{F2}... declaration of conformity drawn up in respect of pressure equipment or an assembly and make them available for inspection by the enforcing authorities for a period of 10 years beginning on the day on which the pressure equipment or assembly is placed on the market.
