The Detergents (Amendment) Regulations 2016

Made - - - - *29th November 2016*
Laid before Parliament *2nd December 2016*
Coming into force - - *1st January 2017*

The Secretary of State has been designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽¹⁾ in relation to measures for safety and consumer protection as respects, among other products, detergents; provisions concerning the composition, labelling, marketing, classification or description of, among other products, detergents⁽²⁾; measures relating to consumer protection⁽³⁾; and measures relating to the environment⁽⁴⁾.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by that section of that Act.
