Categorisation as public transport or commercial operation

Public transport - exceptions - introductory flights

- **15.**—(1) This article applies to an introductory flight (as defined in article 2 of the ^{F1}... Air Operations Regulation) which meets the criteria and conditions described in article 6(4a)(c) of that Regulation.
 - (2) A flight to which this article applies—
 - (a) is—
 - (i) a commercial flight for the purposes of Part 4; and
 - (ii) a non-commercial flight for all other purposes; and
 - (b) must—
 - (i) except when conducted by gliders or balloons, start and end at the same site;
 - (ii) be operated by day and in compliance with the Visual Flight Rules;
 - (iii) be overseen by a person nominated by the relevant organisation mentioned in article 6(4a)(c) of the FI... Air Operations Regulation to be responsible for the safety of those involved; and
 - (iv) comply with any other conditions which may be specified by the CAA.
