

## SCHEDULE 1

Article 4

1. The Secretary of State must determine the species and category of animal, specified in columns 1 and 2 of the table in paragraph 5 into which the non-bovine animal falls.

2. The age of a non-bovine animal is its age at the date on which the notice of intention to slaughter is served.

3. The weight of a pig is its weight at the date on which the notice of intention to slaughter is served.

4. The compensation payable is the amount specified in column 3 of the table, by reference to the applicable species listed in column 1 and the applicable category listed in column 2 of the table.
