**The Equality Act 2010 (Gender Pay Gap Information) Regulations 2017**

**Information to be accompanied by signed statement**

**14.**—(1) The information published under regulation 2 must be accompanied by a written statement which—

- (a) confirms that the information is accurate; and
- (b) is signed in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) Where the relevant employer is—

- (a) a body corporate other than a limited liability partnership within the meaning of the Limited Liability Partnerships Act 2000<sup>(1)</sup>, the written statement must be signed by a director (or equivalent);
- (b) a limited liability partnership, the written statement must be signed by a designated member (see section 8 of that Act<sup>(2)</sup>);
- (c) the partners in a limited partnership registered under the Limited Partnerships Act 1907<sup>(3)</sup>, the written statement must be signed by a general partner (see section 3 of that Act);
- (d) the partners in any other kind of partnership, the written statement must be signed by a partner;
- (e) the members or officers of an unincorporated body of persons other than a partnership, the written statement must be signed by a member of the governing body or a senior officer;
- (f) any other type of body, the written statement must be signed by the most senior employee.

(3) In this regulation, “partnership” means—

- (a) a partnership within the Partnership Act 1890<sup>(4)</sup>;
- (b) a limited partnership registered under the Limited Partnerships Act 1907; or
- (c) a firm, or an entity of a similar character, formed under the law of a country outside the United Kingdom.
