The Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Regulations 2017

Notice of civil penalty

12.—(1) Where a person does not comply with a compliance notice served under regulation 11 the enforcement authority may require the person in breach to pay a civil penalty in accordance with regulation 13.

(2) Where the enforcement authority decides to impose a civil penalty, the enforcement authority must serve a notice of civil penalty on the person in breach.

(3) A notice of civil penalty must—

- (a) be in writing;
- (b) be dated;
- (c) set out the reasons for which the penalty is imposed;
- (d) set out the amount of the penalty and how it has been calculated;
- (e) set out how to pay the civil penalty;
- (f) require payment before the end of a period of 28 days after the date of the notice;
- (g) include an explanation of the steps the person in breach must take if the person in breach wishes to object to the civil penalty, including the manner and form in which any notice of objection must be served; and
- (h) include an explanation of the steps the enforcement authority may take to recover any unpaid penalty.
