MERCHANT SHIPPING

The Merchant Shipping (Work in Fishing Convention) (Consequential Provisions) Regulations 2018

Made - - - - 24th October 2018

Laid before Parliament 29th October 2018

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1(2)

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated(1) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(2) in relation to measures relating to the safety of ships and the health and safety of persons on them.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and sections 85(1)(a) and (b), (3), (5), (7), 86(1) and (2) and 302 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995(3).

In accordance with section 86(4) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995 the Secretary of State has consulted the persons referred to in that section.
