Bank Recovery and Resolution Directive

104. Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/962 of 16 June 2016 laying down implementing technical standards with regard to the uniform formats, templates and definitions for the identification and transmission of information by competent authorities and resolution authorities to the European Banking Authority according to [Directive 2014/59/EU](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council⁽¹⁾.

be contained in the detailed records and the circumstances in which the requirement should be imposed(7).
