The Universal Credit and Jobseeker's Allowance (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2018

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 123(1)(a), 135(1), 136(3) and (5)(b), 137(1) and 175(1) and (3) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992⁽¹⁾, sections 4(5), 12(1) and (4)(b), 35(1) and 36(2) of the Jobseekers Act 1995⁽²⁾ and sections 10(4), 11(4) and (5)(a) and 42(1), (2) and (3) of, and paragraph 4(1) and (3) of Schedule 1 to, the Welfare Reform Act 2012⁽³⁾.

In accordance with section 173(1)(b) of the Social Security Administration Act 1992⁽⁴⁾, the Social Security Advisory Committee has agreed that the proposals in respect of these Regulations should not be referred to it.

In accordance with section 29(7) of the Scotland Act 2016⁽⁵⁾ the Secretary of State has consulted the Scottish Ministers.
