The Equine Identification (England)
(Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018

Sift requirements satisfied 5th December 2018

Laid before Parliament 21st December 2018

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1(2)

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by—

- (a) in relation to regulation 1, the powers mentioned in paragraphs (b) and (c);
- (b) in relation to regulation 2, section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(1);
- (c) in relation to regulation 3, section 8(1) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 7 to, the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018(2).

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(3) in relation to the common agricultural policy(4).

The requirements of paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 7 to the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 (relating to the appropriate Parliamentary procedure for these Regulations) have been satisfied.
