

SCHEDULE 3

Specific conditions: selling animals as pets

^{F1}... Sale of animals

5.—(1) [^{F2}No animal of any of the following descriptions may be sold as a pet, or sold with a view to being resold as a pet, by or on behalf of the licence holder—]

- (a) unweaned mammals;
- (b) mammals weaned at an age at which they should not have been weaned;
- (c) non-mammals that are incapable of feeding themselves;
- (d) puppies, cats, ferrets or rabbits, aged under 8 weeks.

[^{F3}(e) puppies or kittens which were not bred by the licence holder.]

(2) The sale of a dog must be completed in the presence of the purchaser on the premises.

[^{F4}(3) In this paragraph, “kitten” means a cat aged less than 6 months.]
