Transitional and saving provisions regarding equipment interference

### Mandatory use of equipment interference warrants

**21.** Until 27th December 2018 section 13 of the 2016 Act (mandatory use of equipment interference warrants) does not apply to conduct authorised by a warrant issued under section 5 of the Intelligence Services Act 1994 M1, or an authorisation given under section 7 of that Act M2, which is in force immediately before 8th August 2018.
