**The Child Safeguarding Practice Review and
Relevant Agency (England) Regulations 2018**

Made - - - - 28th June 2018

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16B(1) and (6), 16E(3) and 16F(6) of the Children Act 2004⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with section 66(3) of that Act a draft of these Regulations has been laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament⁽²⁾.
