- (b) procedures to announce any developments in accessibility policy in the United Kingdom relating to public sector bodies' websites and mobile applications;
- (c) findings from the implementation of the accessibility requirement;
- (d) information on the training and awareness-raising activities undertaken by the Minister for the Cabinet Office; and
- (e) information on the use of the enforcement procedure.
