## Commencement of section 132 of the Policing and Crime Act 2017 and transitional provision

- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), section 132 of the Policing and Crime Act 2017 (applications under the Firearms Acts: fees)(1) comes into force, insofar as it is not already in force, the day after the day on which these Regulations are made.
- (2) Subsections (3) and (5) of section 132 are treated as though they are not in force in relation to an application made before 1st October 2019 for—
  - (a) an approval under section 15 of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988 (approved rifle clubs and muzzle-loading pistol clubs)(2); or
  - (b) a licence under the Schedule to the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988 (licence for firearms and ammunition in museums)(3).
