## The Law Enforcement and Security (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

### PART 14

#### Extradition

##### Amendment of the 2003 Act

- 53.**—(1) The 2003 Act is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 204 (transmission of warrant by electronic means) <sup>M1</sup>—
- (a) in subsection (1)—
- (i) in paragraph (a), omit the words from “in a case” until the end;
- (ii) in paragraph (b), for “and the alert are” substitute “ is ”;
- (b) omit subsection (2);
- (c) in subsection (5), omit paragraph (a);
- (d) in subsection (6), omit paragraph (a) together with the word “and” immediately after it.
- (3) Omit section 212 (article 95 alerts) <sup>M2</sup>.
- (4) In section 215 (European framework list), omit subsections (2) and (3).
- (5) In section 223 (orders and regulations) <sup>M3</sup>, in subsection (6)(a), omit “section 215(2)”.
