CHAPTER 1

Amendments: legislation that extends to England and Wales only

Amendment of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998

24.—(1) Paragraph 9 of Schedule 3 to the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (procedure where persons are sent for trial under section 51 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998) ^{M1} is amended as follows.

(2) In sub-paragraph (5)—

- (a) at the end of paragraph (a), insert “ or ”;
- (b) omit paragraph (aa).

(3) Omit sub-paragraph (5A).
