**The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019**

**PART 5**

Trade

CHAPTER 5

Exports and imports, and related activities, in relation to [F1non-government controlled Ukrainian territory]

**Supply and delivery of infrastructure-related goods**

**49.**—(1) A person must not directly or indirectly supply or deliver infrastructure-related goods from a third country to a place in [F1non-government controlled Ukrainian territory].

(2) Paragraph (1) is subject to Part 7 (Exceptions and licences).

(3) A person who contravenes the prohibition in paragraph (1) commits an offence, but it is a defence for a person charged with that offence to show that the person did not know and had no reasonable cause to suspect that the goods were destined (or ultimately destined) for [F1non-government controlled Ukrainian territory].

(4) In this regulation, “third country” means a country that is not the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man or [F1non-government controlled Ukrainian territory].
