Trade licences

65. The prohibitions in [^{F1}Chapters 2 to 6 and Chapter 6B] of Part 5 (Trade) [^{F2}(other than the prohibitions in Chapter 4IA of that Part)] do not apply to anything done under the authority of a licence issued by the Secretary of State under this regulation.
