The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

PART 8

Information and records

Part ^{F1}8]: supplementary

79.—(1) A disclosure of information under regulation 78 ^{F2}or 78A] does not breach any restriction on such disclosure imposed by statute or otherwise.

(2) But nothing in ^{F3}those regulations] authorises a disclosure that—

- (a) contravenes the data protection legislation, or
- (b) is prohibited by any of Parts 1 to 7 or Chapter 1 of Part 9 of the Investigatory Powers Act 2016 ^{M1}.

(3) Nothing in this Part is to be read as requiring a person who has acted or is acting as counsel or solicitor for any person to disclose any privileged information in their possession in that capacity.

(4) ^{F4}Regulations 78 and 78A do] not limit the circumstances in which information may be disclosed apart from ^{F5}those regulations].

(5) Nothing in this Part limits any conditions which may be contained in a Treasury licence or a trade licence.

(6) In this regulation—

“the data protection legislation” has the same meaning as in the Data Protection Act 2018 (see section 3 of that Act) ^{M2};

“privileged information” means information with respect to which a claim to legal professional privilege (in Scotland, to confidentiality of communications) could be maintained in legal proceedings.
