**The Export Control (Amendment) (EU Exit) (No. 2)  
Regulations 2020**

*Coming into force - -at 10.59 p.m. on 31st December 2020*

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8C(1) of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Export Control (Amendment) (EU Exit) (No. 2) Regulations 2020 and come into force at 10.59 p.m. on 31st December 2020.

**Amendment of the Export Control (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020**

2. In the Export Control (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020(b), in regulation 7(9), in the text of paragraph (28B) to be inserted in regulation 4 of the Export Control (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019(c), after the text of article 42N(2)(a) contained in that paragraph, for “and”, substitute “or”.

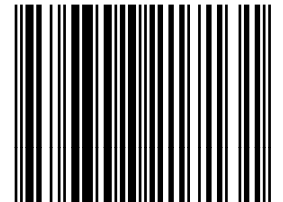
